A Decade of Growth Establishes Shanghai as an APAC Market Hub

Market Scale

China, as one of the world's top three art markets, continues to demonstrate immense potential. Shanghai has solidified its position as China's most crucial art trading hub. Since 2022, it has entered a "CNY 10 Billion+" trading environment and is advancing towards a "CNY 100 Billion+" target.

In the 2023-2024 period, the transaction value of Chinese photographic art saw a 48% year-on-year increase, confirming the market's position in a high-growth phase, characterized by robust vitality and promising prospects.



A Decade of Growth Establishes Shanghai as an APAC Market Hub

Industry ecology

The ecosystem for photo-based art in China is maturing. The number of photography and video exhibitions has grown by 250% compared to a decade ago, with significant increases in professionalization and institutionalization. Taking Shanghai as an example, by 2021, the city was home to 96 private museums and cultural institutions, hosting 950 exhibitions and 3,953 public programs annually, attracting 6.21 million visitors. Academic support and institutional networks collectively form a strong foundation for the recognition and dissemination of value in image-based art.

Exhibition Guidelines

- Commercial galleries or agencies with a consistent exhibition history who present a minimum of 4 exhibitions per year in their own business premises, external project spaces or art fairs are invited to apply.
- Joint applications are welcome, however nust be made separately with each party signing an application form and agreeing to the Terms and Conditions.
 A minimum booth size of 40 sqm applies to joint applications.
- Selection is based on the curatorial strength and premise of the gallery's exhibition program, representing artists and the proposal for PHOTOFAIRS Shanghai. PHOTOFAIRS Shanghai prioritizes galleries showing new bodies of work or blue-chip vintage work, with curated solo or 'solo within group' exhibitions preferred.
- As collectors attend the Fair to view new work, artworks shown previously at PHOTOFAIRS Shanghai are discouraged, Submission of your application does not automatically confer the right of admission to PHOTOFAIRS Shanghai 2024. Decisions on admission are made exclusively by PHOTOFAIRS Shanghai.
- Booth allocation is determined and approved by the Fair Management. Please refer to the Terms and Conditions for further details.

Customs & Taxes

- PHOTOFAIRS Shanghai and our nominated shipping agent wil undertake customs clearance and inspection, for both inbound and outbound movement in Shanghai. This applies for all international shipments but does not apply for local shipments.
- No Import Tax will apply for inbound shipment, as the works will be imported on a temporary basis. All artworks(including sold exhibits that return to China) need to return to Customs after the exhibition.
- Artworks that are sold and shipped outside of China will be subject to local tax regulations of the client. For artworks that remain in China, they are subject to Permanent Import Tax and VAT, which is 14.13% on the declaring value of the work.


